- 1. The Procedure for the evaluation of Responsive Tender offers will be method 3 (Financial offer and reference) with the 80/20 preference points system.
- 2. Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of the tender are contained in the tender document.
- 3. The Department reserves the right not to award to the lowest bidder. In addition, the Department will conduct a detailed risk assessment prior to the award of the bid.
- 4. No tender documents will be issued at the pre tender briefing meeting and no site inspection meeting certificates will be issued at the pre tender briefing meeting.
- 5. Bidders who attend without a bid document will not be allowed to the briefing.
- 6. No late arrivals will be admitted to the pre tender briefing meeting.
- 7. Telegraphic, faxed, e-mailed, and late Bids will not be accepted. Bid documents may only be submitted on the Bid Documentation that is issued.
- 8. Late submissions will not be accepted. Tenders / Representatives have the right to be part of the opening of tender / quotation, hence the DOPW won't be held liable for any queries that could be raised by the public / tenderers themselves after the opening of tender has been done.
- 9. Only Bidders registered on the Provincial Suppliers Database and within the applicable CIDB grading or Higher will be legible to submit bids / quotations.
- 10. Bidders must submit Certified B-BBEE or EME certificates issue Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor.
- 11. All material must be SABS Approved
- 12. Non completion of SBD 6.2 Declaration Certificate for Local Content Production and content designated sectors and its annexures will lead to disqualification of Bid.
 - 12.1. Steel and concrete products that is 100% locally produced or locally manufactured and from local raw material or input will be considered
 - 12.2. Only locally produced or locally manufactured steel products and components for construction with a 100% minimum threshold for local production and content will be considered
