3. Tender Documents must be purchased prior or downloaded from e-Tender Portal before the starting time of tender briefing meeting.
4. The bid document can be downloaded from e-Tender Portal at no cost. However, should any bidder require a printed/hard copy of the bid document, a non-refundable payment must be made for collection of the bid document.
5. Proof of payment from the bank will be needed prior to handing over the Bid document, No EFT payments and its proof will not be accepted. Original deposit slips issued only and stamped by the bank teller.
6. Bidders who attend without a bid document will not be allowed to the briefing.
7. No tender documents will be issued at the tender briefing meeting and no site inspection meeting certificate will be issued at the tender briefing meeting.
